
What LGNC membership supports:

- Access to the Lehigh River


Memberships help LGNC maintain our trails year round and provide free community access!

Nestled within the Kittatinny Ridge, alongside the Lehigh River, Lehigh Gap Nature Center (LGNC) is a non-profit, member-supported conservation and environmental education organization. Through our efforts to revegetate a once barren and polluted mountainside, LGNC has created *the first and only nature center in the United States on a Superfund site*. This is our story...



Just a few decades ago, much of the Lehigh Gap area was a 'moonscape.' Nearly a century of industrial pollution, though accidental, left behind 3,000 acres of contaminated land virtually devoid of life. In 1983, the Environmental Protection Agency established a Superfund cleanup site to restore the affected land. With the founding of the Lehigh Gap Wildlife Refuge in 2002, LGNC launched a project to heal a piece of this broken landscape.

LGNC's transformation from Superfund to super habitat has been a grassroots effort from the start, led by a small group of volunteers with a bold vision of hope. With support from numerous partners, LGNC used native prairie grasses to build the foundation of a new ecosystem upon several hundred acres of denuded mountainside. Today, this ecosystem thrives. And while we continue to restore the land, we are also working to strengthen the connection between people and the natural world through education, research, and outdoor recreation.
